We have always wanted to offer the best care and medicine for your pets, and this state-of-the-art medical center has been a dream of mine for many years. Our team of doctors work to keep up with the latest knowledge and protocols in the industry. We also make every effort to have the best tools and equipment to enhance our ability to diagnose and treat your pets.

While new equipment has been added over time, we have increased the number of additions in the last few years in anticipation of the new medical center. Some of these enhancements have included our comprehensive animal physical therapy unit, a surgical unit that replaces ligatures for blood vessels and drastically reduces surgery time, digital radiographs for general and dental use, an extensive dental suite for advanced dental procedures, cold laser for healing wounds and chronic lesions, and new machines for faster diagnosis and for presurgical screening. These equipment enhancements, in addition to others, enhance our ability to

care for your pet and help diagnose diseases early, bettering the quality of life for your animal.

The new medical center will have a room for a spiral CT scan, a larger recovery and critical care area, a larger physical therapy area, a special procedures room for ultrasound and endoscope equipment, and expanded space throughout the building making your experience at our clinic better for you and your pets. With an increased number of exam rooms, your waiting times will decrease and you can enjoy the park-like design of the new lobby. A full pharmacy and lab with a pharmacy technician will speed up your prescription process, and a separate phone room will handle your phone calls better.

We are also excited to announce that we are combining Snips & Snoozes with the clinic in the new building. This will allow for larger kennels and a more pleasant environment for your pets while they stay with us. Another exciting addition will be our luxury boarding area to offer larger spaces, play areas, a fountain and themed "guest" rooms: Key West, Charleston, San Francisco, Santa Fe, etc. Another benefit of the merge will be the close proximity of the doctors, should any of your animals need attention.
